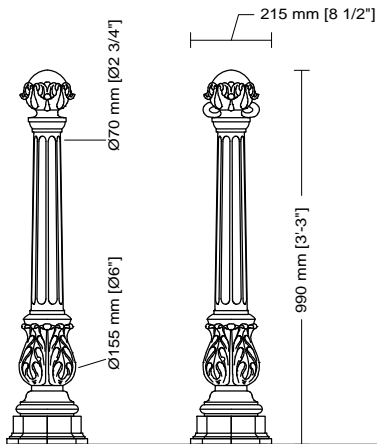

Bollard

Series: Layia - Heritage

Product description

Bollard made of spheroidal graphite cast iron. Octagonal base, truncated conical body decorated with four leaves and eight flutings and upper part with rings for possible fixing of chain, surmounted by a sphere decorated with four leaves.

Series description

The Layia series includes the entire range of street furniture: bench, sign, litter bin, bicycle rack, planter, fountain, ashtray, bollard, railing and notice board. Flutings and floral decorations have been designed to match the posts of the Sheliak lighting system.

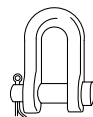

Components

The support is constituted of a cast iron column with an octagonal base that rests on a listel at ground level. The column is a truncated cone (lower diameter: 85mm [3 1/4"]; upper diameter: 70mm [2 3/4"]) and is decorated with eight flutings.

The component at the base of the bollard is surmounted by a torus, joined with four leaves 175mm [7"] high with a central diameter of 155mm [6"].

The end component is made of cast aluminium and is fixed to the top of the support with two lateral M6 dowels in stainless steel.

The end component has two rings fused to the column suitable for the chain entry, above the rings the decoration takes the shape of a sphere whose lower half is decorated with four leaves.

ACCESSORIES

The bollards can be completed by chain and shackle, carabiner or stirrup.

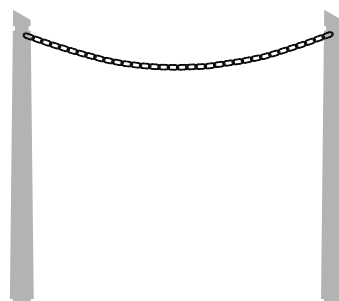
